Property was cheap, big libraries were being sold off and before long Booth had filled the town with books and booksellers. In 1977 Hay gained international recognition when Booth declared it to be an Independent Kingdom of Books. Forty-five years on, Hay and its Festival continue to flourish. We have seen off the threat of Amazon and Kindles and more book towns are being set up - from South Carolina to South Korea. 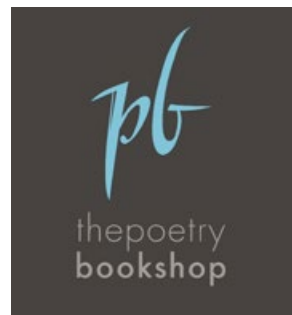
